

IS CONVICTED UNDER IMMIGRATION ACT

Kain Mandeff is Remanded for Sentence—Others are Involved.

At the immigration detention room at the station on Saturday night a man named Kain Mandeff was charged before Magistrate Mackay with bringing in ten men to work for one of the large railway contracting firms in violation of the Immigration Regulations.

The men had been instructed to pass themselves off as Austrians, who under a temporary regulation, are allowed to come in for railway construction work, when in reality, they were Bulgarians, to whom the privilege is not extended.

The charge was sustained and Mandeff remanded for sentence. During the investigation it came out that several parties had been brought in during the last month, involving several officials of the company for whom summonses are now out.

Provincial Constable Connor is away now serving the summonses and the case will be resumed this week.
