

AUSTRIANS CALLED HOME

Letter With Names Following Cable to Winnipeg

Winnipeg, July 29—General mobilization of Austrian army reserves in Western Canada was ordered today when a cable reached the Winnipeg office of the Austro-Hungarian consul. A letter from the Austrian war department, confirming the cable and giving the names of first reservists recommended to return home, is now on the way to Winnipeg, and will reach the city in eight days. The expense of carrying war reservists from Winnipeg back to Austria will be borne by the government. Letters to Austrian reservists, telling them to be prepared for a call home, will be sent out in the next few days.
