

FOREIGNERS HERE READY TO LEAVE FOR SEAT OF WAR

Numbers of Residents Discuss All
Important Topic on Streets
This Morning.

AWAIT CALL TO COLORS

Poles Will Leave Immediately It
Becomes Certain that Russia
Is Involved.

More interest is being shown to-day in the war situation in Europe, by the foreign element in Brandon, and groups of Austrians and Poles were to be seen on Rosser this morning, discussing the all absorbing question.

Inquiries made from the more prominent people living across the tracks, show that quite a number of Austrians are prepared to leave for the seat of war at a moment's notice, though none, so far, have taken their tickets either at the C. P. R. or C. N. R. depots. The first to make a move will be the reservists of the Austrian army of whom there are a large number in Brandon, and these declare they are now waiting for the "proper" papers, calling upon them to rejoin the colors.

If Russia takes a hand in hostilities, a large number of Poles living here will undoubtedly seize the opportunity of taking up arms against their hereditary foes, and will speedily cast in their lots with anyone opposed to the Russian bear.
