

Austrians Leaving to Fight.

Montreal, July 30.—The German liner Millahad, now in port from Rotterdam and Antwerp, will carry back to Europe the first Austrians to sail from Montreal to the seat of war. When the vessel clears from this port Saturday morning or possibly on Sunday morning there will be at least two hundred of the local Austrians on board hurrying back to Austria at the call of the emperor. Five thousand Austrians in Montreal are supposed to answer the call of the sovereign for they are in the first and second reservists. Quite a number of the colony have become British subjects and so are exempt from military service in the conflict. Austrian labor agencies are crowded today. On the door of each one is posted in a conspicuous place the order from the local consul requiring the first reservists to leave for home at once. They are to report to him to arrange for passage and other things. The notices are dated the 28th instant and stamped with the local seal.
