

GERMANS IN WESTERN CANADA TO RUSH TO WAR

WINNIPEG, August 1. — Baron Rudt von Collenberg, representative of Emperor William in Winnipeg and Western Canada, announces the consulate besieged with Germans anxious to enlist and return to Europe for the fighting. Hundreds of reservists have already placed themselves in touch with the consul, awaiting the expected call to arms. Letters and telegrams have been received from points in all the western provinces stating enthusiastic allegiance to the emperor during the present trouble.

The German consul states that although no official word had been received by him advising of a declaration of war by Germany, he was getting in touch with Canadian reservists in expectation of a call.
