

LABOR AGENT IN COURT

Charged With Illegally Conducting Employment Bureau

George Alexander, 1 St. James St., appeared before Judge St. Cyr yesterday afternoon on a charge of conducting an employment agency without a license. Seven foreigners, witnesses in the case, claimed that they had paid Alexander \$5 to get them a job, and that he had paid their way to St. Catharines, where they had been obliged to find their own work. When they returned, they discovered that the fare was only \$2. The defence pleaded that all the money taken was to pay the complainants' travelling expenses and board for a week. The case will be continued next Monday.
