

GERMAN OFFICER REPORTED IN CITY

Militia Headquarters Chiefs Try to Locate Visitor—Would Become Prisoner of War.

Local M.D. headquarters last night were notified that a high German military officer has registered at the Royal Alexandra hotel. It was stated that his rank was that of major-general. The name was given as Kunta. Steps were immediately taken to locate the officer, but it was found that no such name appeared on the register. There is every reason to believe, however, that Major-General Kunta was at the hotel. Every effort has been made to locate the gentleman, who, if located, will unquestionably be made a prisoner of war.

So greatly had the headquarters officials been impressed that an officer was detailed in endeavor to find some trace of the German officer. Up to a late hour last night, however, he had not been located. The trains will be watched, and, if he has not already managed to leave the city, he will be detained. It is possible that he may be detained at the border should he make an effort to get across to Germany via the United States. The fact that the officer had been reported as being at the hotel was confirmed at M.D. 10 headquarters.
