

# GERMAN IS ARRESTED

Has Large Quantity Of Dynamite In His Possession

TORONTO, Aug. 2.—A number of detectives and constables surrounded a house on the Kingston road this afternoon, and after taking Harry Gercke, a German, and a woman who says she is his wife, into custody, searched the premises. They found ninety-six sticks of dynamite, which were confiscated.

The woman was given her freedom, while Gercke was held without bail on a charge of having dangerous explosives in his possession. Gercke, it is alleged, stated that the explosives had fallen from a wagon on the Kingston road, and that he had found it there.
