

AUSTRIAN HEAVILY FINED YESTERDAY IN POLICE COURT

**Fred Serboluk Was Assessed
\$194 and Jail Term for
Attack on F. Gregory.**

At the city police court yesterday Fred Serboluk, an Austrian, was convicted on three charges. He was fined \$194.40 and costs and sentenced to spend six months in prison, with an additional six months in default of paying the fine, for an attack on Frank Gregory, who finding the man where he was not supposed to be at the steel plant, had chased him out. Serboluk was also fined \$25 and costs for having a revolver and another \$25 and costs for having a shotgun concealed, with the option of spending thirty days in jail in each case.

Mrs. Maggie Desmond was given two years in the Mercer reformatory for keeping a common bawdy house on Gore street. J. E. Shier was given one year as a vagrant and Joseph Desmond, charged with being a vagrant, was allowed out on suspended sentence. Gordon Lowery and Robert Wallace were each fined \$20 as frequenters.
