

**AUSTRIAN CONSULS
MUST LEAVE CANADA
WITHOUT ANY DELAY**

Order Follows Declaration of War Upon Austria by Great Britain.

THOSE WHO FAIL WILL GET PASSPORTS

Austrian Reservists Who
Attempt to Leave Will
Be Arrested.

BUT FEW HAVE TRIED

Authorities Believe That
Very Few of Them De-
sire to Leave.

Ottawa, Aug. 13—Now that there has been a formal declaration of war between Great Britain and Austria, the government will without delay take the same action in regard to the Austrian consuls as was taken in connection with the German consulates in Canada. In other words, they will be given notice that they must close up their offices and leave the country. Should any of them fail to do this they will be handed their passports.

The order relating to the arrest of German reservists who attempt to leave this country will now be extended to Austrian reservists. It is stated that very few German or Austrian reservists have made any serious attempt to get out of the country.

Officers of the militia department who visited the Valcartier camp on Sunday state that the workmen who are engaged in digging trenches and putting up targets include three camps, one of Austrians, another of Germans and still another of Italians. Despite the war there has been no trouble. It is believed that while the number of Austrians in Canada exceeds the number of Germans there are fewer of them who will have any desire to leave to take part in the war. The majority of Austrians here it is believed come to Canada to escape conscription and have no idea of returning to become targets on the field of battle.
