

## Looking For Other Germans.

Orders have been received at the local military headquarters to be on the look-out for the four Germans who made their escape from Gananoque on Wednesday afternoon, while the other four men were rounded by the police and placed in the cells. The local police and the military authorities have been instructed to arrest any Germans who might answer to the descriptions of the four men who are still at large.

Chief Ryan, of the Gananoque police department, stated it was his intention to follow the men in an automobile.

It is stated that the four Germans who were caught, stated that they came from Kingston, where they had been working on the street railroad construction work, likely on Princess street, but they were never here.

It is not known what will be done with the four men but it is expected that they will be detained at the request of the military authorities until the war is over.

It is believed by some that it may have been the intention of the men to try and do some harm to the train which is to take the R.C. H.A. to Quebec.
