

# AUSTRIAN PRINCE AT MONTREAL CONSUL- ATE UNDER ARREST

Montreal, Aug. 13.--Alfred Hohenlohe, an Austrian prince, who has been attached to the Austrian consulate in Montreal for several months, was arrested this-afternoon at the instance of the militia headquarters. Prince Hohenlohe was taken to his apartments on Dorchester street west, where he was questioned and where some of his papers were impounded. Then he was allowed out on parole.

The prince comes of an old German family and Bismarck's successor as chancellor of the German empire was a grand uncle of Prince Hohenlohe. His father was prime minister of Austria some years ago.
