

# Calgary Germans Rather Nervous

Will Not be Molested at All  
if They Are Only  
Discreet

---

Calgary, Aug. 13.—Seeking the protection of the American Consulate eight Germans, five of whom were naturalized citizens of the United States, called on United States Consul Reat and asked that this protection be accorded them and every other German in Calgary. Mr. Reat stated that every American citizen, native born and naturalized, would receive the protection of the Consulate, but added that no protection whatever could be accorded citizens of Germany or any other foreign country.

Owing to the recent developments in the war situation the Germans in Calgary who are not naturalized citizens of this country naturally occupy a rather delicate position. But they have not been molested to date, and probably will not be if they are discreet enough not to give expression to any anti-British sentiments.
