

# FIVE MORE AUSTRIANS TAKEN IN CHARGE

## It is Thought They Were Reservists Bound for the Front.

Mr. Geo. Boyd, superintendent of the Government Dock, was yesterday afternoon instrumental in the arrest of five more Austrians.

The foreigners arrived on the Athabasca at a quarter to three and Mr. Boyd immediately took charge of them and told them they would have to go up town with him, that they might receive passports. They resisted for a time, but Mr. Boyd used all his persuasive powers and succeeded in getting them to the armory without any trouble.

On their arrival there they were placed under arrest and with the other four captured this week are being held pending instructions being received from Ottawa. They are incarcerated at the district gaol.

They were proceeding to Montreal, where they intended to embark for Europe. It is thought that they are reservists.
