

NO RUSH TO BE NATURALIZED

Number of Applications in the Sault Does Not Exceed Normal.

When interviewed yesterday afternoon, Mr. C. V. Plummer, clerk of the High Court, stated that there was no noticeable increase in the number of applications for naturalization papers for Canada through his office.

From several points throughout the Dominion, it is reported that foreigners are swarming legal offices with the intention of becoming naturalized and thus avoid future trouble in case the war in Europe exceeds the large proportions it has now.

When interviewed Crown Attorney F. J. S. Martin stated that the number filed through the district court is slightly above the normal, which is likely accounted for by the European war.

Mr. Martin states that although the number filed with him has been a slight increase over the ordinary, it does not nearly amount to the number filed prior to the local option election last January.
