

GERMAN IS ARRESTED. CROSSING THE BORDER CARRYING A STILETTO

NEW WESTMINSTER, Aug. 24.—A young German, named Walter Klock, appeared before Magistrate Clute this afternoon charged with carrying concealed weapons, and was remanded for eight days. Klock, who was captured at White Rock on Sunday evening by Constable Hibbin, was attempting to cross the boundary line near Blaine, and was stopped by the American immigration authorities. He is only 31 years of age, and states his father is an officer in the German army.

When searched a stiletto was found, also papers setting forth the fact that he was a reservist in the German army. Klock appeared unconcerned over his arrest, and said that if he did not report to the Fatherland he would be shot, so he might as well make an effort to get home.
