

PRISONERS OF WAR

Nine Austrians and a German Arrested at Windsor.

Windsor, Ont., Aug. 25.—Nine Austrians were found on a Wabash train here and are being detained as prisoners of war. They had tickets to Austria and were to have sailed today from New York. The prisoners are under guard at the armories and may be sent to the detention barracks at Kingston.

F. H. Berger, a well known business man of Detroit was detained here as a prisoner of war. Papers were found on him which later led to verification of the fact that he was an officer of the German army and was on his way through Canada, en route to the scene of war. He has been sent to the detention barracks at Kingston.
