

TWO AUSTRIANS ARRESTED

In Connection With the Smith's Falls Shooting.

SMITH'S FALLS, August 30—Two Austrians were taken into custody Saturday afternoon in the Long Bush, a strip of woods about fifteen miles from this town and are held in connection with the death of Patrick Moran, the C. P. R. guard who was murdered in the early hours of Saturday morning by an unknown whom he challenged. Moran was able to give a good description of his slayer before he succumbed, and possees were immediately organized to scour the surrounding country. The trail led to the two men who were eventually arrested and they will come up for a hearing tomorrow morning.

Moran stated that the man who shot him wore a light grey coat and one of the Austrians wears a garment of this description. The Austrians state that they left Ottawa Friday but have so far not given a good account of where they spent Friday night.
