

GERMAN - AUSTRIAN PATENTS IN CANADA TO BE SUSPENDED

Rules of Imperial Government Will be Adopted by Dominion

OTTAWA, Sept. 8.—It is probable that within the next few days the Canadian government will formally announce the suspension of all German and Austrian patents held in Canada. The period of suspension will be during the war and for six months afterwards. Action by the Canadian government has been delayed until the receipt of the rules adopted by the Imperial government in this connection. These have now been received from Hon. G. H. Perley, and the Canadian government will act as indicated above.
