FOREIGNERS IN CANADA MUST GIVE UP WEAPONS

But No Trouble is Anticipated By Brandon Police.

Ottawa, Sept. 2.—An order-in-council prohibits the possession in Canada by an alien enemy of firearms, ammunition, dynamite, gunpowder, or

other dangerous explosives. Such persons are required to deliver up all arms or explosives within ten days to

a justice of the peace or an officer or constable of the mounted police. In suspected cases a search may be made without warrant. If this takes

place after the ten-day period the offender shall be liable to a fine of \$500 and imprisonment for three month
