

# *Canadian German Does Not Like it*

## *Thinks Paper Preaching Sedi- tion Should be Forbidden Mails*

Our townsman, Mr. Barney Scheerer, who is a stalwart Canadian German, has been receiving through the Walkerton postoffice copies of The Free Press of Lincoln, Nebraska, a seditious German publication which is seeking by trenchant articles and fiery appeals to stir up the Germans against Great Britain and her allies in the present war. Barney is thoroughly aroused—not against the British people, but against the publishers of the Lincoln rag who could presume that he would stomach such stuff and rebel against a flag that has given him and other Canadian Germans a greater freedom than they could ever know under the iron rule of the military-crazed Kaiser. As a result Barney thinks that a ban should be put on the Lincoln publication and its further circulation through the mails of Canada stopped. Like most citizens of German descent here Barney believes that the Kaiser is entirely in the wrong in the present war, and would like to see Britain and her allies successful in their great laudable stand for the freedom and democracy of the world.—Walkerton Herald and Times.
