

# *German Spy Had — Plans of Petawawa*

## *Arrested and Taken Under Guard to Prison at Fort Henry*

Kingston, Sept. 16.—With maps of Petawawa Camp and surrounding district in his possession, a German spy was arrested at Morrisburg and brought to Fort Henry yesterday. He is regarded by the military authorities as one of the most dangerous prisoners yet to be brought to Kingston. A special guard from the 69th Regiment arrived with the prisoner who speaks four languages and understands military codes. He was arrested at Morrisburg as he was about to cross over to the American side.

J. H. Berger, a German, brought here from Windsor some time ago, and allowed out on parole, was re-arrested in Ottawa and brought back to Fort Henry for violating his parole.
