

German Urged Son To Return to War

Letter to Ontario Teuton Was Written Before Outbreak of War

A letter written by a German residing in Berlin to his son in Canada, calling the latter home to fight for the Kaiser, has been brought to the notice of the Provincial authorities, who now possess the document. The letter was written on August 1st, the day upon which Germany declared war on Russia, and before any definite move was made on France.

After anathematizing France, the

veteran father calls on his son to hasten back and help write "an improved edition of 1870."

"If they want murder," he writes, "by all means they can have it, and they can be shot at as they run away as far as the rifle carries."

The letter concludes by instructing the young man to apply to the nearest German Consul for funds and directions for the return home.
