

SUSPECTED SPY FREED

Young German Questioned by Justice Dept. Officials.

A suspected German spy was under examination yesterday afternoon by an officer of the Justice department. The suspicions proved unfounded, the young man establishing the fact that he is a native of Luxembourg and that residence in Ottawa is wholly with peaceful intent. He was formerly employed in Montreal as an importer's clerk, but lost his position and came to reside near Ottawa with a couple of others. His practice with a rifle aroused the suspicions of neighbors, who reported the matter to the Dominion police and the young man was asked to come up to the government offices and give an account of himself. He succeeded in establishing his neutrality and was allowed to go.
