

ARRESTS AT MORDEN

Foreigners Found to Have Deadly Weapons in Their Possession.

Morden, Man., Sept. 23.—The arrest of three foreigners supposed to be Poles, by Chief of Police James McCorquodale about noon to-day, caused a great deal of excitement when it was learned that the men had firearms, dynamite, fuse and caps in their possession.

The prisoners arrived in town this morning and went to a local hardware store to purchase revolver cartridges. The hardware clerk told the police about them, and the chief located the men at the C.P.R. bridge and tank at west end of the town. Only one seemed to resist arrest and endeavored to draw a revolver but was overcome before charging same. Six large sticks of gelatin it out of his pocket or dynamite with fuse were located under the bridge and caps were found in the possession of one of them. The arrested men will likely get a preliminary hearing to-morrow morning. The authorities have had the prisoners transferred from the local to the Provincial jail.
