

In connection with the arrest recently at Morrisburg of a man suspected as a German spy, the statement is made here that he is the gentleman who was in Pembroke for a couple of weeks, selling western oil stock. No name is given in the report printed in the press regarding the arrest, but it is announced that he had maps of Petawawa camp and surrounding country in his possession and that he was about to cross the border to the United States. He is regarded in military circles as one of the most dangerous prisoners yet brought to Kingston. He speaks four languages and understands military codes. The man who was in Pembroke claimed to be of Belgian descent and that his home was in Montreal, and people who were with him at the hotel here had their suspicions aroused before he left here.
