Work to Which Church Must Set Its Hand

Toronto, Oct. 14—The annual meeting of the Baptist Convention of Ontario and Quebec opened tonight in Walmer Road church with a large assemblage of delegates. President W. E. Norton, in his inaugural address, outlined the work which the church must undertake during the coming year. The greatest work, he said, is which the church must set
