

GERMAN RESERVIST MUST NOT LEAVE CANADA

When the world went to war, all German reservists in Toronto were required to sign a declaration, in which, among other things, they promised not to leave the Dominion. To-day a German reservist appeared at Military Headquarters and asked if he could cross the border into the United States. He could not get work here, he said, and wanted to try his luck on the other side. He assured the authorities that he was very friendly to the British Empire, and had no intention of going back to fight for the fatherland. The authorities not only assured him that it would be impossible to leave the country, but required the German to sign a declaration that he would not attempt to leave.
