

## Foreigners May Make Trouble.

MONTREAL, Oct. 24—Police Chief Campeau is urging the Board of Control to take immediate steps to deal with the problems arising out of the presence in Montreal of thousands of destitute Austrians and Germans.

He has drawn up a statement for the board in connection with the serious situation which exists in the city.

It is made clear by the chief that, if there is not a much more intelligent and stringent supervision of the foreign quarters, conditions here will be dangerous in the extreme during the coming winter.
