

A Montreal steamship ticket agent is under arrest on a charge of treason, his offence being that he gave comfort to the King's enemies by selling tickets to a number of Austrian reservists and advised them as to the best way to avoid detection in their attempted escape from Canada to the firing line. The case is one of considerable interest for the reason that it makes clear the fact that it is an offense to even sell a ticket to either an Austrian or a German during progress of the war, if the ticket contemplates a trip beyond the boundaries of Canada.
