itia, but the cabinet generally has given a good deal of thought to the subject. The militia will direct the attention of municipal authorities to the danger of harboring unemployed enemy aliens in any number within their borders, and make a strong effort to induce municipal authorities to provide work for them, but it is

not expected that municipalities will be able to take care of them all, for it is estimated that at the very least there are 40,000 enemy aliens in the

lowed to go about in idleness. One of the plans which seems to find favor with the government is to place these men in Dominion parks through the country and set them to work clearing the fallen trees, cutting them into logs and firewood, and doing general work of this kind. This firewood could either be sold at cost or given to the families of the soldiers who have gone to the front. Perhaps, also, it might be used to alleviate the distress of impoverished families during the coming winter.

order-in-council passed two days ago, requiring aliens of enemy nationalities to report to the registration offices, will apply to Turks, Greeks or those of any other nationalities whose fath-erland may declare war against the allies.
