

# PROVIDE FOR ALIENS

A communication has been received by Secretary F. T. Fisher of the Edmonton Board of Trade from the secretary of the Montreal Board of Trade in which the conviction is expressed that the Austrian and German residents of Canada who have been thrown out of employment as a result of the war will become a serious menace to the country. Edmonton is asked to be represented in a deputation that will wait upon the officials at Ottawa this week for the purpose of placing the situation before them, and asking for action and control of the situation by the Dominion Government.

Mr. Fisher said yesterday that energy the deputation proposed to extend was not needed because the government was well aware of the situation and of its outlook, and thus would take in hand the situation and make provision for the unemployed Austrians and Germans now on Canadian soil.
