

Former Official Arrested As Spy

Arthur Lauf Taken In at Halifax—Had a Wireless Apparatus.

Ottawa, Ont., Nov. 4.—Arthur Lauf, formerly in the Canadian Immigration service, has been arrested in Halifax accused of being a spy. Lauf has been under suspicion for some time. He was arrested immediately after the war broke out, but was released on the production of naturalization papers. Recently he was again arrested and his rooms searched. A complete wireless apparatus was discovered.

Lauf will be interned as a prisoner of war.
