

MOUNTED POLICE ALL KEPT IN WEST

Only Few Reservists Were Allowed to Rejoin Their Regiments

ALIENS ARE RESTLESS

Dominion Congratulates the "Sydney" on Capture of "Emden"

Ottawa, Nov. 11.—"It is impossible to allow any of the Northwest Mounted Police to go to the front. Their services are very necessary at the present time," said Comptroller Fortesque to-day.

The force is now up to full strength, namely 1,200, or with officers and other officials, a total strength of 1,272 officers and men. Fifty-four Imperial reservists who were in the force have rejoined the colors. Before they went an arrangement was made whereby they will be taken on again when they return from the war.

Constant vigilance on the part of the Mounted Police is necessary to preserve order amongst the foreign population and Comptroller Fortesque is welcoming the approach of winter weather to cool the ardor of the pugnacious aliens.
