works department. The doctor has been employed as an engineer on drainage work for the past two years, and Works Commissioner Harris gave him a very good character, saying he had retained him in the de-

partment after consultation with the police and military authorities. When the war broke out, Dr. Kohlman was put on parole and reported to the authorities.
