

5,000 MEN AT CAMP BY THE END OF THE YEAR

2,000 Soldiers are to Be Mobilized at the Exhibition Grounds.

Nearly 2,000 more soldiers are to be mobilized at the Exhibition camp, in addition to the 2,200 infantrymen already there. It is expected that probably by the end of the year a force of 5,000 men will be concentrated at the Fair Grounds. The new orders call for the mobilizing of a divisional ammunition park of 7 officers and 464 men, a divisional supply column of five officers and 265 men, and a divisional field bakery of one officer and 92 men. These men are all to be drawn from Toronto, and recruiting will commence shortly.

The advance party of the Field Ambulance corps will take up quarters at the Exhibition grounds tomorrow, and the main body of 244 men will go into camp on Thursday, using the stock buildings for quarters.

The Mounted Rifles, drawn from the Mississauga Horse and the Governor-General's Body Guard, are now assembling at the Exhibition Grounds, small detachments going in each day. The total strength of the Mounted Rifles is 525 men and 27 officers.
