

## TURKS BUSY COLLECTING CLAD IN CLERICS' ROBES

Nine Turks were arrested last night by Detectives Montgomery and Croome, following complaints from citizens that they had been swindled by foreigners who were collecting money for an orphanage which the police say does not exist. The men, who were dressed in clerical clothes, and described themselves as priests and clergymen, were arrested at their boarding-houses, 170 George street and 124 Shuter street. They said their names were Semeon Elias, Stymo George, Joseph Ella, Meson Salva, Durka Zayan, John Andres, Uram George, John Wasley and Michael Daniel.

The men after being arrested were loud in their praises of the British Empire. Some of the men speak good English.

All were well supplied with money. One man had three hundred dollars on his person, while others had smaller sums of money.
