MANY ALIENS REGISTERED. Nearly three hundred alien ene-

mies, mostly Austrians, are now being registered daily at the recently established bureau on St. Antoine street, in charge of Mr. Silas H. Carpenter, and the total number of registrations to date is in the vicinity of fifteen hundred. The men are coming in with good regularity on the days appointed, and the outside staff, whose chief work is to visit defaulters, has not been required to a very large extent in this matter up to now. The entrance to the registration bureau is almost constantly blocked with foreigners waiting their turns to be interviewed by the chief registrar, and the work is proceeding rapidly now that the staff has been thoroughly organized. Posters in German, warning all Austrians, Germans and Hungarians to report at the bureau are now a evidence throughout the city and district.
