London, Nov. 30.—There is no truth in the report which has appeared in some newspapers here and may perhaps have got circulation in Canada that members of the Canadian contingent have been sent home because it has been discovered that they are of German or Austrian origin.

As the press despatches have no doubt told you a few members of the contingent have been sent out of camp.

Very few, however, have been guilty of any misconduct and nothing that has been done is of any serious consequence or reflects in any degree on the contingent as a whole.
