

PETEWAWA CAMP BEING PREPARED FOR ALIEN ENEMIES

Several Hundred Germans and Austrians To Be Kept for Duration of War

OTTAWA, Dec. 8.--Petewawa military camp is being whipped into shape to quarter several hundred alien enemies, who will be kept there for the duration of the war.

Maj. De La Ronde, went up to Petewawa last week to supervise the operations and a small army of carpenters and other tradesmen will be at work shortly, preparing for the arrival of the Austrians and Germans to be rounded up there.

Petewawa was considered the finest military camp in Canada previous to the whirlwind establishment of Val-

cartier, but there is still a lot of work to be done there. The government, it is believed, sees an excellent opportunity of having the labor done at a minimum cost, and the aliens, no doubt, will have to work for their board.

It has been announced that the Aus-

trians and Germans held here will be developing their muscles in cutting roads this winter. The concentration at Petewawa is believed to be part of this scheme, as the military camp is just on the outskirts of a country where there is a lot of work to be done.
