

M'GILL IS FREE OF TROUBLE

No Germans On the Staff—A Swiss is Teacher of German.

Montreal, Dec. 7.—"It is a matter I do not care to discuss," said Principal Peterson of McGill to-day regarding the action of Toronto University in relieving three German professors of their duties and of Sir Edmund Osler's resignation as a result of their being given full salary.

"However, if you insist on quoting me," Principal Peterson continued, "You may state that there hasn't been any trouble in McGill, nor will there be. As regards Germans on the staff, I refuse to discuss them."

Dr. Adami, one of the staff, explained why there has been no talk.

"It is all because there is not a German of any description on our staff," said Dr. Adami. "The nearest approach we have is Professor Walther, who teaches German. His name may sound German, but he is a Swiss."
