

Alien to Stand Trial

Saskatoon, Dec. 21.—Arthur Steiner, who calls himself a Bulgarian engineer and a land buyer representing German capitalists, was arrested here by the mounted police, and has been sent to Regina to stand trial on a charge of obtaining \$50 by false pretense, from the Schwatzfield department store of that city. It is understood that half a dozen charges will be laid against him. He has been in the country for some weeks purporting to be an agent for large German buyers of land, all of which gave rise to wild rumors that there were Germans in the country trying to buy land for bases in Canada. A number of cheques with rubber stamp signatures of Regina firms were found on him.
