Windsor, December 23.—Confessing that he had intended to enlist in the third Canadian contingent and to act as a spy for the German army. Anton Gaus, twenty-three years old surrendered himself to the immigration officers because, he says, his conscience troubled him. Gaus is finely educated and speaks seven languages. He says he arrived in the United States four years ago from Berlin, Germany, near which city his father conducts a large merchandise establishment. He left Germany, he said, to escape con-

scription.
