FULL HOUSE OF ALIENS

St. to Go to Petewawa

Another full house at the quarters

for interning alien enemies on St. Antoine street was reported yesterday evening at the registration bureau, the number having again reached the

neighborhood of a hundred and twenty-five. These men will be transferred today to the Petewawa station to leave room for the others that Re-

gistrar Silas H. Carpenter may find it necessary to confine during the next few weeks. Two batches of internes have at-

ready gone to Petewawa from Montreal, 180 men in all. Seven thousand have been so far registered in this city, namely about 5,500 Austrians and

1,500 Germans, with half a dozen Turks. Aliens of Austrian nationality alone are sent to Petewawa, the Germans being drafted to Kingston. A number of men have been trying to evade the rules put in force by the registrar in the matter of reporting at regular intervals, and some have been found to give wrong addresses on their first visit to the bureau, with a view to shirk the reporting, it is thought. Several of these men, who had given a certain address on Chabot street, which was found to be the address of a grocery store only. were rounded up by the registrar's staff at their work, and found to be living in different parts of the city and not on Chabot street at all.
