

1,800 ALIENS IN CAMPS.

Distress Through Lack of Employment Greatly Augmented.

Ottawa, Jan. 5.—From the larger centres of population in Canada 1,800 Germans and Austrians have been interned in concentration camps, and any distress consequent upon their being out of work has been greatly relieved. Hundreds more have registered and are reporting regularly, but so far have proved self-supporting. Twenty-seven alien enemies were taken from Ottawa to Kingston to-day.
