

The protest against the naturalization of Prof. Mueller, of the University of Toronto, one of the three German professors who were given leave of absence by the university until after the conclusion of the war, was disposed of by Judge Coatsworth, who said in his finding: "Mr. Mueller responded to the supreme test when, after deliberation, he answered that he was in favor of the success of the British in the present war. There is not one tittle of evidence against Mr. Mueller that would justify me treating him at all differently from any of the others."
