

German Professor Quits Toronto

Toronto, Jan. 22—Prof. Immanuel Banzinger, who recently resigned his chair in the university of Toronto, was yesterday granted his exeat by the alien registration office, following his formal application. This permits him to leave the country within 12 days. Prof. Benzinger told the alien office he expected to leave for Princeton at once. He stated that he was not going to Princeton as a lecturer, as had been stated, but on a personal visit to a friend, and he will remain in New Jersey until summer.
