

Wanted to be Sent Back to Germany

Jumped Bail in Toronto, is Arrested in Chi- cago

If Louis Berger, who is wanted here on a charge of larceny, is deported to Canada by the Chicago authorities, as requested by the Toronto police, he will be interned as a prisoner of war for the duration of hostilities, according to information available in Toronto to-day.

Berger jumped his bail of \$1,000 and then asked the Chicago police to deport him to Germany, it is said. The local department are negotiating for his extradition, however.

Berger is not registered at the local Bureau for Alien Enemies—at least not under the name of Berger.
