

Two Released War Prisoners Have Flown

A few days ago two prisoners of war at Fort Henry were allowed their liberty on bail furnished by a local merchant. The men were to report regularly, but on Tuesday they did not report and it is understood that they are now in New York city. The release papers for one of them arrived on Wednesday, but the money put up as bail will have to be forfeited by the merchant, who, however, is not likely to lose anything. It is likely that in future no more prisoners of war will be allowed their liberty on the same conditions.
