

The jury in the criminal assizes at Toronto, last week, after being out an hour, returned a verdict of "not guilty" against Paul Mazur, the Austrian charged with high treason. "I entirely agree with the verdict you have rendered," said his lordship, Chief Justice Sir Wm. Mulock. Although acquitted of high treason, Mazur will be handed over to the military authorities to be dealt with for the statutory offence of assisting aliens out of Canada. He is charged with directing foreigners across the international boundary.
